Today, we invite you to help to build urgent support for survivors by donating an auction item towards our annual fundraising gala, Celestial Nights.

This special event will take place on November 4, 2023 at St. George Banquet Hall and will include entertainment, dinner, dancing, a live and silent auction, and more. Our goal is to raise \$50,000 for our Individual Counselling program, which will provide 1,000 sessions of counselling for those in need.

In 2019, the Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives named Waterloo Region the least safe place for women to live in Canada, based on police reports of sexual and gender-based violence.

At the Sexual Assault Support Centre of Waterloo Region, we know the prevalence of sexual violence in our community is undeniable. A day spent in our office reveals this difficult truth. The phone never stops ringing.

Requests for individual counselling at our Centre have skyrocketed in recent years; for the first time in our history, over 200 survivors of sexual violence are on a year-long waitlist for one-to-one care. Despite the significant need, funding has not kept pace with demand. As such, we are fundraising to help ensure support is there when survivors need it.
