

Sloka Case Timeline

2017 – 2018: Accusations Surface

- Sexual abuse accusations from former patients surface
- There is a hearing from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, prohibiting Sloka from being unaccompanied with his patients

2019: Sloka stripped of licence and later charged

- Sloka stripped of medical licence, could no longer practice
- Arrested, facing 34 counts of sexual assault. Alleged victims, were 34 of his former clients, from 17 to 51 years old

2021: More charges laid

- 76 sexual assault charges by 2021, but today only facing 50.
- Trial begins; Sloka pleaded not guilty

2022: Trial continues

- Neurology expert, Dr. Vera Bril, claims Sloka exhibited medically inappropriate behaviour

2023: Sloka testifies

- Sloka takes the stand
- Evidence portion concludes in Oct 2023

November 2025: Closing arguments

March 31, 2026: Victims Speak

- Anonymously speaking to media, victims note, “So much of life has happened while this is in the back of your head at all times. It is exhausting — mentally, emotionally, physically exhausting.”

April 24, 2026: Verdict

- Sloka found not guilty of 48 counts of sexual assault after a five-year trial
